Hindi writer. Apart from articles, he has also published in Hindi a book on literary criticism, a poetry book in English and two collections in Hindi. For want of

leisure, he wrote less and published little in the past. The author belongs to an agrarian family, settled in a backward region of old Madhya Pradesh. He now

lives in Bilaspur, Chhattisgarh (India.) He finds his roots in Indian thought. He believes in monism, which is the source of most human values like love,

compassion, forgiveness, help and service, etc. and which negates all that are due to the sense of otherness--- for example, hatred, envy, exploitation, cruelty
